ABOUT WORLD CAFÉ (ROUND TABLE DISCUSSIONS)

The objective of this is to facilitate an engaging dialogue among nursing professionals, educators, policymakers, students, and researchers on the challenges, best practices, and opportunities in public health nursing within a global context. Through sharing experiences, insights, and innovative approaches, participants will gain a deeper understanding of the multifaceted role of nurses in addressing positive public health change worldwide. Cafés will be three (3) sessions of approximately 15-20 minutes in length with usually 8-10 participants per table.

Cafes are a great way to generate ideas and to explore different points of view and speak to numerous people. The world café offers a flexible format that can be adapted to fit many different topics. They foster collaborative dialogue, encourage active engagement, and can offer constructive possibilities for action. Opportunities for interactive elements such as case studies, group activities, or Q&A sessions are encouraged to promote engagement.

In a Conversation Café presentation, each speaker will be limited to a specific format: discussions will be held around a table without digital display capabilities. The slides are typically set to automatically advance, keeping the presenter on a strict timeline. This format encourages speakers to be concise, focused, and visually engaging.

Key features of a World Cafe include:

- Session Length: 15-20minute sessions
- Number of Sessions: 3 sessions per hour
- Format: Small group discussions
- No need for audio-visual displays

By adhering to these guidelines, the round table discussion on public health nursing in a global context can serve as a valuable platform for fostering collaboration, innovation, and advocacy in addressing pressing public health challenges worldwide.
